4. EXAM MAKE-UP – Students who have an excused absence from an exam may make arrangements with their teacher to make up the exam during the Exam Make-up Sessions. Students may also arrange with teachers to make up exams during Resource Periods.
5. TECHNOLOGY CENTER OF DUPAGE – There will be no TCD classes for students on exam days.
6. QUIET STUDY AREAS – Supervised quiet study areas will be available for those students who wish to study during the exams, when they have a free period. All Physical Education and Driver Education classes WILL MEET ON EXAM DAYS. There are to be no students in the halls without a pass during the exam periods. All students are to remain in their classes during the entire period.
7. RESCHEDULED EXAMS – Students who feel they have a heavy load of exams on Day 1 or Day 2, may elect to change or move one of their exams during the Rescheduled/Make-up time slot on Day 3. All exam reschedules must be completed 1 week before the final.
8. SCHOOL CODE – School Code requires that Districts schedule a minimum of 300-minutes of instruction and student support during the last day of each academic semester. Passing periods do not count toward the 300-minute requirement.
9. SEMESTER GRADUATES – Tuesday, January 10, 2017 is the last day for seniors who will be graduating at semester. Classroom teachers are to provide written notification to the student and/or guardian no later than January 5th if an early graduate is required to take a final exam. All final exams will be taken during the regularly scheduled exam time.
10. ATHLETICS – Practices may begin after 1:30 p.m. Students should check with their coach for actual start time.
