## Glenbard East High School Health Requirements for 2019-2020

We would like to welcome your student to Glenbard East High School. Below you will find the medical requirements for students entering 9<sup>th</sup> grade. Please return the following information to the Glenbard East Health Office no later than August 1<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

## 1. HEALTH EXAMINATION AND IMMUNIZATION RECORD

(School Board Policy No. 7:100 & IL School Code Section 27-8.1)

Each ninth-grade student must present proof of immunizations and have a new physical exam completed on the Certificate of Child Health form prior to attending class as a freshman. Physicals should be completed between August 15th 2018 and August 1st 2019. If your student does not furnish a new health examination with the complete immunization history by the first day of school, they will not be allowed to attend classes. Schedule your appointment now, as there will be <u>no exceptions</u>.

- Please use the correct form. The Certificate of Child Health form which is attached, or a computer-generated form from your physician are the only forms accepted. A copy of this form may also be used by Athletics if your student will be participating in a sport. Physicals completed on the IHSA Sport physical form cannot be accepted as the 9<sup>th</sup> grade physical.
- Please be sure the immunization record is complete, current and accurate.
- Please complete and sign the Health History on the physical form (top section). Forms that are missing parent data and/or a signature will be returned for completion.
- Please be sure the examining physician (M.D. or D.O.) Advanced Practice Nurse, or Physician Assistant signs and dates the form
- Please return completed forms to the Glenbard East Health Office in the envelope provided as soon as the physical is completed. Forms may also be faxed to the School Nurse at 630-424-6438.

## 2. SCHOOL DENTAL EXAM

Recently signed into law on August 13, 2018 as Public Act 100-0829 and effective January 1, 2019. It amended the Illinois School Code expanding the requirement that all children in kindergarten, 2nd and 6th grades, now adding 9th grade, have a dental examination before May 15 of each year. If proof of a dental examination is not submitted to the school, the school may withhold the child's report card.

## 3. <u>SCHOOL MEDICATION FORM</u>

All prescribed and over-the-counter medications that need to be administered to your student during school hours must be registered in the Health Office by completing the two-sided District #87 School Medication authorization form. This form is available in the Health Office or on-line at <a href="http://www.glenbardeasths.org">http://www.glenbardeasths.org</a> (click on the Nurses page under the Parents heading). Both a physician and the parent/guardian must sign the medication form. Students may not have any medication in their possession except for asthma inhalers, EpiPen's or insulin pumps that have been prescribed by their physician and shown to the School Nurse.
