The Illinois Department of Public Health requires all students entering or continuing in Grade 12 to show proof of receiving two doses of the meningococcal vaccine on or after the 11<sup>th</sup> birthday or one dose if the initial dose is given on or after the 16<sup>th</sup> birthday.

For your convenience, immunizations are available through your physician's office, Walgreens Take-Care Clinics, and at Jewel-Osco pharmacies. The DuPage County Health Department also offers immunization services. Please call (630) 682-7400 for an appointment.
