Dear Parent or Guardian,

The Illinois Department of Public Health requires all students entering or continuing in Grade 12 to show proof of receiving two doses of the meningococcal vaccine on or after the 11th birthday or one dose if the initial dose is given on or after the 16th birthday.

Schedule your appointment now. For your convenience, immunizations are available through your physician's office, Walgreens Take-Care Clinics, and at Jewel-Osco pharmacies. The DuPage County Health Department also offers immunization services. Please call (630) 682-7400 for an appointment.

Please return this completed form to the Health Office prior to the start of your child's senior year. This is a senior year requirement mandated by the Illinois Department of Health. Your child will be excluded from school if this requirement is not met. Documentation may be hand delivered or mailed to the health office or faxed to 630-424-6438.
