Deans

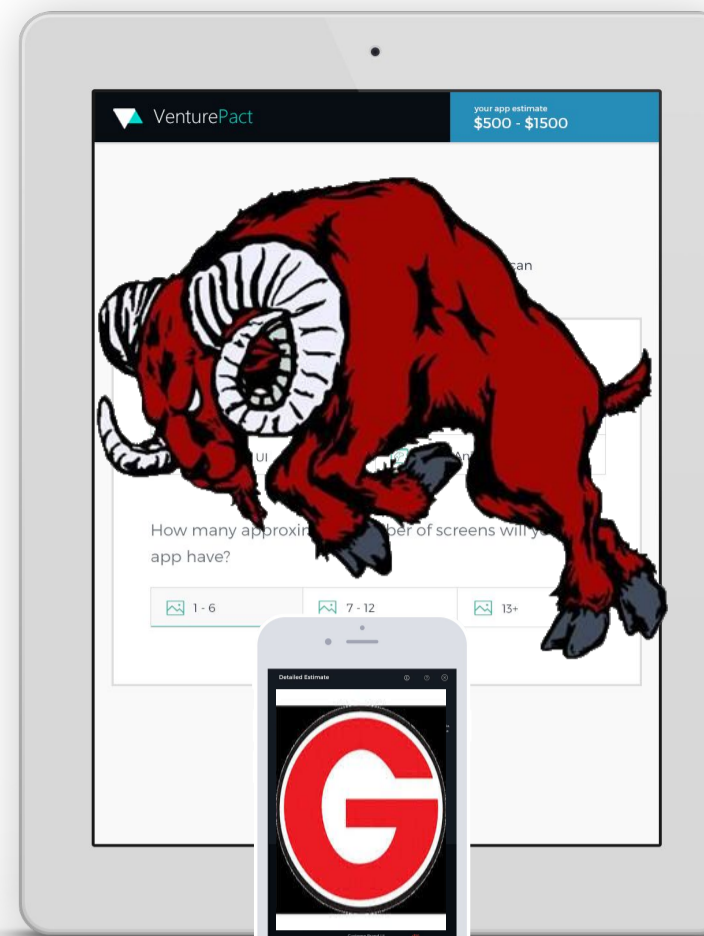
Our Dean's office closely monitors students who struggle with school engagement and provide behavioral interventions to re-engage students in the learning process.
